What is the focus of the Leadership Training workshop?

- Self-assessment
 - *To enhance self-awareness and leadership styles, self-expression and social interaction.*
- Team building
 - *To participate in a series of team building initiatives in order to understand that effective teamwork is an integral part of the leadership process.*
- Community Service
 - *To emphasize on the importance of community involvement through volunteerism.*
 - *Students will participate in an off site service project*
 - *Students will handle pre-planning tasks for the service project and evaluate the project after completion.*

What are the Enrollment and the attendance requirements?

- *Students must complete the program application.*
- *Attendance for both days is required*
- *Students are encouraged to participate in the annual Leadership Worthington Service Day on the first Saturday in May.*
